



Checklist for patients prior to adenoidectomy



IMPORTANT!



- Patients must be in good overall health before the surgery (no acute cold or fever).



- Patients must not eat or drink on the day of the surgery.



- Patients (or their representatives) must know about any of chronic diseases they have, previous surgeries, medication they are on (preferably have it with them).



- Patients (or their representatives) must have the following exams carried out not earlier than 10 days prior to surgery:

- automated blood test, coagulogram (APTT, SPA, INR);
- blood glucose test and blood type test;
- electrocardiogram (ECG).

Test results must be within the reference range.

All of these exams can be done in 2 to 3 hours in our centre on the day of the surgery or beforehand for an additional fee.
